



LINDAU NOBEL LAUREATE MEETINGS

SELECTION CRITERIA

FOR THE 6th LINDAU MEETING OF THE LAUREATES OF THE SVERIGES RIKSBANK PRIZE IN ECONOMIC SCIENCES IN MEMORY OF ALFRED NOBEL

The Meeting of the Laureates of the Sveriges Riksbank Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel in Lindau will be held from 22 – 26 August 2017. The audience for lectures, panel discussions, and special discussion sessions will be up to 400 young economists (graduate/post-doc students and young professionals).

The participants will be recruited worldwide among (a) most promising young scholars in economic sciences and (b) young and highly qualified economists from research institutions. The Review Panel of the Council for the Lindau Nobel Laureate Meetings selects academic candidates for participation based on the following criteria:

- A young economist should be under 35 years of age, belong to the top of his/her class, and have strong recommendations from his/her academic advisor.
- A candidate should have a promising research agenda. Post-docs or early tenure-track scientists should have produced outstanding research papers on relevant subjects.
- A candidate should show a pronounced interest in the international dialogue within the academic community.
- A candidate should demonstrate fluency in the English language.
- Finally, the candidate should be motivated and willing to prepare himself/herself solidly for the Lindau Meeting.

(1) Graduate students shall

- have excellent academic records
- have at least initial research experience
- have at least initial tutoring and/or teaching experience

(2) Postdoctoral or early tenure-track scientists shall

- have no more than 5 years of postdoctoral experience
- have published in widely recognised academic journals
- have presented their research at international conferences
- have acquired solid experience in tutoring and/or teaching
