Joint Research Program Solicitation Announcement
Fu Jen Catholic University and

Western Sydney University / University of Economics Ho Chi Minh City / University of Tsukuba

1. **Project Solicitation Period:** Open from now until 12:00 noon, **May 25, 2026**. Late submissions will not be accepted.
2. **Project Implementation Period:** **August 1, 2026, to July 31, 2027** (One-year plan).
3. **Application Limit:** Each faculty member is allowed one approved application.
4. **Funding Scheme:** Each approved project may receive up to **NT\$250,000** from **FJCU'** s internal research fund. Additional funding may be provided subject to the availability of corporate sponsorship, with the final amount to be determined upon approval.
5. **Applicant Qualifications:**
 - (1) The project principal investigator (PI) must be a full-time or adjunct faculty member from either institution. Researchers from third-party institutions may participate with the approval of both PIs.
 - (2) Applications are not accepted under the following conditions:
 - i. Previous recipients who have not completed the project and submitted a final report within two month after the project period's end.
 - ii. Previous recipients who have not published SCI, SSCI, or A&HCI co-authored papers within two years after the project period's end.
 - (3) Funding Provisions: The PI may apply for the following subsidies based on the project's actual needs:
6. **Funding Provisions:** The PI may apply for the following subsidies based on the project's actual needs:
 - (1) Personnel costs: Compliant with the university's relevant regulations.
 - (2) Service fees.
 - (3) Equipment costs.
7. **Planned Cooperation Topics: Applicable to all fields.**

8. Application Method:

- (1) If the project involves human experimentation, please attach documentation of submission to or approval from the Human Experimentation and Medical Ethics Committee.

For projects involving genetic recombination, include documentation of submission to or approval from the Biological Experiment Safety Committee.

If the project includes animal experimentation, provide documentation of submission to or approval from the Animal Experimentation Ethics Committee.

For projects involving individuals or groups through intervention or interaction, or the use of identifiable personal data for systematic investigation or scholarly inquiry, documentation of submission to or approval from a research ethics review shall be provided prior to project implementation.

- (2) Project leaders at Fu Jen Catholic University who have already received funding for three research projects under these guidelines must submit application records for integrated projects from government agencies related to the aforementioned research topics before applying for additional funding.
